Fast Alert® Chosen For Washington State's Entire Puyallup School District

PORT ANGELES, WA—March, 2009—Incident Alert Systems (IAS) of Port Angeles, Washington announces that Washington State's Puyallup School District, the ninth largest district in the State of Washington, has elected to install its Fast Alert® Incident Warning and Management system into 100% of its educational facilities to help assure the safety of students, faculty and employees. Fast Alert had previously been installed at all secondary schools within the Puyallup School District to provide critical, campus wide communications in the event of a natural or manmade emergency. The district has twenty two elementary schools, seven junior high schools, three comprehensive senior high schools, and an alternative school, serving close to 22,000 students; all of which will soon have immediate communication between teachers, staff and first responders during emergency situations.

Patent protected Fast Alert® is a bi-lingual, computer-enabled, incident warning and management system with mobile, all-platform, management capability. The system can be activated by cell phone, PDA, tablet computer, laptop or desktop computer for direct and immediate communication, providing warning of imminent or in-progress life threatening events. IAS proprietary software makes available a menu of alert options, including lockdown, evacuation, shelter-in-place and all-clear alerts. The system can be installed in several configurations, the most common being integration with an existing intercom system with a connection to the data network. By utilizing Infrastructures already in place, the Fast Alert system can be introduced as a retrofit upgrade at a very low cost.
