**Puyallup School District Installs Fast Alert® For Incident Warning
and Management**

PORT ANGELES, WA—January 1, 2008—Incident Alert Systems (IAS) of Port Angeles, Washington announces the installation of its Fast Alert® incident management and security system at all secondary schools within Washington State’s Puyallup School District. Patent protected Fast Alert® is a computer-enabled, incident warning and management system designed by IAS specifically for direct and immediate communication between teachers, staff and first responders during an emergency situation in which expedient and concise information flow is of the essence.
