Washington State's Sedro-Woolley High School Installs Fast Alert® From Incident Alert Systems For Superior Incident Warning and Management

Fast Alert, which has been awarded US patents and has International patents pending, can be installed in many configurations including connections with existing data networks and integration with existing intercom systems.
